

WorkLog used with CWorks, by DWIGtech Associates

The WorkLog reads and writes directly to the CWorks database. It greatly simplifies the task of creating and reporting on Work Orders, and is quickly adopted by Maintenance Tradesmen. It is very easy to use and,

- ensures all work details are reported, only one screen to fill
- provides a picture of work on every shift for Maintenance & Production
- gives simple access to repair history of any machine
- writes to the Work Order database for later analysis

Clicking on the WorkLog icon on the desktop, brings up the screen below
